4. I request a copy of the City of Livonia job posting for the job title of recreation leader, recreation specialist and program specialist. I also request a copy, if any, of the City of Livonia job posting for the job title of lifeguard.
5. I request one copy of the employment applications for the four City of Livonia employees on duty at the Clements Circle Pool on August 4, 1996.
6. I request one copy of any City of Livonia in-service training and workshop attendance records for lifeguards during 1996.
7. I request one copy of any written reprimands or memos of verbal reprimands in the employee files of the four City of Livonia employees on duty at the Clements Circle Pool on August 4, 1996.
8. I request one copy of any record of the date and time spent with the four lifeguards on duty at the Clements Circle Pool on August 4, 1996 in Critical Incident Stress Debriefing (CISD) and the name, address and phone number of the people that provided CISD services.
9. I request a copy of the list of all telephone and radio channels which are recorded on your audio logging system at your 9-1-1 public safety answering point.
10. I request a copy of the manufacturers name and the model number of any audio logging system used by the City of Livonia to record 9-1-1 telephone calls and radio transmissions.
11. I request one copy of the invoice issued for the purchase of a bag-valve mask resuscitator if a bag-valve-mask resuscitator was available at the Clements Circle Pool on August 4, 1996.
12. I request one copy of the invoice issued for the purchase of supplemental oxygen if supplemental oxygen was available at the Clements Circle Pool on August 4, 1996.
13. I request a copy of any written bloodborne pathogens protection standards issued to City of Livonia lifeguards designed to protect employees from disease transmission.
14. Pursuant to my previous Freedom of Information Request, I received a narrative report dated August 6, 1996 regarding this drowning, incident #96028912. The author of this report is Livonia Police Sergeant Gregory Winn from the Livonia Police Detective Bureau. In this report he writes Lifeguard Angela Bell "states the victim was breathing irregularly, his lips were blue and he was spitting up blood." Lifeguard Ann-Margaret McLean states she "grabbed the cash box and raced through the men's locker room and ran to the deck and found the victim laying on his side moaning and spewing blood on the floor. She ran back to the office and grabbed the mouth shield for the victim had stopped breathing, Ann-Margaret states that Angela administered CPR and she took over with mouth to mouth." Mr. Dean Henry said "he further observed the victim spit up blood and water." In addition, Mr. Thomas Ihlenfeldt stated, "Mucus, blood and water came out of his (victim) mouth and he (victim) began to moan." I request a copy of any written communications issued to your employees and pool patrons involved in this rescue informing them of their possible exposure to bloodborne pathogens.
