

15. As the victim was "spewing blood", the pool deck was soiled with blood or body fluids. According to your daily "Michigan Department of Public Health Swimming Pool Operation Report", the pool deck was never cleaned after this incident or at anytime during the August, 1996 reporting period. I request any documentation that indicates when and how this biohazard was mitigated.

16. Pursuant to my last Michigan Freedom of Information Act request, you sent me a copy of a City of Livonia Police Department incident report #96028912 written by Officer Parrinello, with information about the Sex, Race, Date of Birth, Drivers License Number, State, Address, Apartment Number, City, State, Zip, Home and Business phone blacked out for fourteen witnesses, complainant and victim. I request an uncensored copy of this information or a full and complete explanation of each of these deletions and the name and title of the official responsible for the decision to withhold the information.

If any information is deleted, please excise the deleted material by a black-out method. If you instead use a white-out or cut-out method, please mark each deleted item on the copy. For audio recordings, if any information is deleted, please beep out this material. Furthermore, I expect a full and complete explanation of each deletion and the name and title of the official responsible for the decision to withhold the information.

I will expect a response to this request within five business days or less as required by the Michigan Freedom of Information Act.
