

The City of Livonia expresses its sympathy for the family of a [REDACTED] boy who passed away as a result of a swimming accident at Livonia's Clement Circle Pool on 8-4-96. Livonia's lifeguards removed the young man from the pool and he was breathing. After a short time passed, the young man stopped breathing and C.P.R. was initiated by lifeguards. Despite the lifeguards efforts and resuscitation efforts by the Livonia Fire Department within 3 minutes of receiving the call, the young man passed away and was pronounced dead at Garden City Hospital. The City of Livonia regrets the loss and expresses confidence that all possible efforts were used to resuscitate the young man according to established procedures.
