

## ADMINISTRATION OF THE VACCINE SHOULD BEGIN WITHIN 24 HOURS OF EXPOSURE.

You should not be vaccinated if:

- you have already received the complete hepatitis B vaccination series.
- antibody testing reveals you are immune.
- you should not receive the vaccination for other specific medical reasons.

## PLAYING IT SAFE

Additional facts you should know:

- If you are exposed, report the incident immediately to your supervisor.
- If you consent, we will provide you with a confidential medical evaluation, including blood tests, any available post exposure preventive treatment and follow-up counseling.
- A free training program during working hours will provide you with updates annually.
- Training will tell about bloodborne diseases, how to use personal protective equipment and how to report an exposure incident. It will also detail your rights and responsibilities as a staff person in the Saginaw Public Schools.

*It is possible to protect yourself from bloodborne pathogens on the job by knowing the facts and taking proper precautions. Being informed will give you confidence in your ability to safely care for the well-being of others and yourself.*
