

I had just gotten up in the deep end guard stand and scanned the area. I noticed someone at the bottom of 10ft. area. I waited 10-15 sec to see if he was just playing. When he didn't come up I used the megaphone to tell Jason to clear the pool and get down off the stand. His little brother said, "Oh don't worry, that's my brother, he holds his breath a long time," but I dove in to get him anyway. I swam him to the side and pulled him out of the pool with Jason's help. He was breathing irregularly and his lips were blue and he was spitting up blood. His breaths were about 5-10 sec apart so I didn't start rescue breathing immediately when his breathing slowed further, I started rescue breathing, tipping his head to the side when he began to throw up. After about a minute, I checked for a pulse and couldn't find one so Ann and I began 2 man CPR. The EMS Gup came and took over.
